The documents to be submitted include:

- Digital portfolio: The digital portfolio should contain a goal-orientated documentation of selected works that demonstrate individual areas of interest as well as creative development and skills. Approximately 20 works are required in the form of digital media, visualisations, photographs, drawings, web links, etc. In addition, information on the context of the work (year of creation, description) must be provided. If it is a team project: Naming of persons involved and labelling of your own contribution.
- Creative task (image, media, text): You develop ideas and an independent implementation for a given problem. The design task will be online from **20th February 2026**. You will receive the link to the task by e-mail.
- CV with photo and chronological details of all qualifications (tertiary and continuing education) and employment.
- Language certificates and letters of recommendation (if available)
- A letter of motivation (max. 4,000 characters without spaces) that reflects your intentions, ambitions and reflections on your personal and professional development to date.
