Part 1

Submission

Submission of documents
16.03.2026 (by 09:00) –
19.03.2026 (until 17:00)

The first part of the admission process consists of submitting a digital
portfolio, completing a visual-analytical assignment, and providing a
motivation letter along with a CV. Details about the submission
formalities will be announced after the application deadline.

1. Digital Portfolio:

The digital portfolio is a visual documentation of selected works and
projects in a PDF file. It highlights the candidate's areas of interest and
artistic ambitions, showcasing at least five projects on one or two pages
each (no more than ten pages in total). Each project must be presented
through one or several images (sketches, drawings, visualisations,
(info)graphics, 3D modeling, installations, conceptual representations,
etc.). Text-based descriptions may be included in the documentation if
it helps to convey the works' meaning. The PDF file may contain links to
web-based animated or interactive content. Download links will not be
accepted.

The works shown in the portfolio must be from artistic or codebased
projects realised in the framework of the foundation course, at school,
during an internship, as an employee or in a self-employed capacity, or
personal initiative. It is essential that your own contribution is clearly
identifiable.

2. Visual-analytical assignment:

You will receive the link to the assignment by email on **February 19,
2026**, after the registration deadline.

3. Attachments:

- Motivation letter (details will be provided with the assignment)
- CV with a chronological list of degrees (tertiary and continuing education), employment history as well as language and other skills

Notification of decision

After your documents have been reviewed, you will be informed about the next steps. If the decision is positive, you will receive an email invitation with the date and time for an aptitude interview. In the case of a negative decision, you will also be notified by email.

Part 2

Interview

Content: A personal interview about your motivation, goals, and the visual-analytical assignment, conducted together with the program director and a faculty member from Data Design + Art.

Period

20.04.–24.04.2026

Duration: 30 minutes.

Notification of acceptance

Until 06.05.2026

Positive decisions and definitive rejections will be communicated until 6th May 2026. To confirm acceptance of a study place, the student agreement must be returned within 7 days of receiving the acceptance notification. Applicants who meet the admission requirements but cannot be offered a place due to limited capacity will be placed on a waiting list and informed via e-mail. You will be notified as soon as a study place becomes available. Please note that all communication regarding the waiting list will be handled exclusively via e-mail. We are unable to provide updates by phone.
