Submission of digital portfolio, artistic assignment and attachments

Documents to be submitted:

- A representative portfolio containing previous artistic works such as videos, photos, drawings, paintings, sound files. In case of collaborations, the scope of the applicant's contribution must be made clear. In the case of multiple films, a written recommendation for three selected works must be enclosed.
- A homework assignment in the form of a film review (film chosen from three set films). The assignment is published online from **20th February 2026**. You will get the link to access it by e-mail.
- Motivation letter in German (about one A4 page)
- CV with photo and chronological list of degrees and certificates (tertiary and continuing education), employment history and language skills
- Language certificates and reference letter (if available)

After your documents have been reviewed, you will be informed about the next steps. If the decision is positive, you will receive an email invitation with the date and time for an aptitude interview. In the case of a negative decision, you will also be notified by email.

To confirm acceptance of a study place, the student agreement must be returned within 7 days of receiving the acceptance notification. Applicants who meet the admission requirements but cannot be offered a place due to limited capacity will be placed on a waiting list and informed via e-mail. You will be notified as soon as a study place becomes available. Please note that all communication regarding the waiting list will be handled exclusively via e-mail. We are unable to provide updates by phone.
