Master of Arts in Fine Arts in Public Spheres, Critical Image Practices and Art Teaching

To enter the admission process apply here until 7th March 2024 and select your major:

A registration fee of CHF 200.00 will be charger and must be paid before completing your application.

Part 1

Application documents

All documents must be uploaded in the online application form (max. file size 2GB).

Pre-education

Your application must include the following files:

- → Diplomas, school reports or certificates with regard to your basic and further education
- → Confirmation of exmatriculation (from previous Swiss universities)
- → Employer references and confirmations regarding your professional activities/experience/work

Foreign diplomas must be accompanied by a translated version (German or English) in addition to the original scan!

Enclosures

- → Passport copy, residence permit (if available)
- → CV
- → Motivation letter (max. one page A4)
- → Portfolio (Documentation of previous, possibly current artistic works, max. 16 pages A4). In case of direct transfer from Bachelor to Master within the Lucerne School of Art and Design, the personal interview will be held at the student's studio space, in addition to the portfolio.
- → Sketch for a project idea (max. two pages A4), which could be implemented within one of the thematic fields of the StudioLabs eco!, post? und ¿wo? as a part of the artistic practice. Further information see here.

Additional requirements for Art Teaching applicants:

- → Documentation of any existing teaching experience or internships, if available
- → Please note that this major is only available in German Students who have not completed a Bachelor's programme in Fine Arts and Art and Design Education might be asked to attend additional foundation courses to catch up on lacking experience and foundational knowledge. An individual assessment will be conducted to determine how to proceed.

Notification of Decision: until 22.03.2024

An acceptance commission evaluates applications and decides who will be invited to part 2 of the admission procedure. The decision will be communicated latest by 22nd March 2024.

Interview

- → Content: Presentation of artistic works, motivation and project idea for the StudioLab, definitive selection for major Public Spheres or major Critical Image Practices
- → Duration: 20 minute presentation; 10 minute interview/ discussion

During a personal interview with the guidance of the commission, we will go through the submitted documents. Please make yourself available for the mentioned period, as the invitation will be sent shortly before . If requested, the interview can be conducted online.

Decision of admission

Notification of acceptance: until 26.04.2024

Admissions from waiting list until the end of June 2024

Costs / Study fees

Accepted applications and definite rejections will be communicated until 26th April 2024. The student agreement needs to be signed and returned within seven days. Applicants, who meet the admission requirements of their chosen programme, but are not admitted due to limited space, will be put on a waiting list. This will be communicated by email. Students on the waiting list will be informed as quickly as possible if a study place becomes available. Please note, that we will not provide any information by phone.

Accepted applications from the waiting list will be notified by email until the end of June 2024.

According to "<u>Study Fees 2024 - 2025</u>", an already accepted study place can be cancelled **until July 31, 2024** without any further costs.
