

Poster Printing with the Canon iPF8400

Prior Appointment

The poster printing with the **Canon iPF8400** is controlled by a local workstation, so print jobs are carried out after prior arrangement only.

The posters can not be printed immediately. Please allow +/-1 week!

Type of Paper

- > Photo paper, satin, 190 g/m²
- > Photo paper, glossy, 190 g/m²
- > Outdoor blue back, 130 g/m²
- > Matte paper high Color Contrast, 140 g/m²
- > Matte paper, 80 g/m² (only suitable for large silkscreens)

Setup of the Print File

The publishing workshop is not available for file editing. Color corrections, size set up, etc. must be prepared by the students. Please prepare your files as follows:

- > File format – TIFF or PSD (reduced to one image layer, portrait format, make crop marks)
- or
- > printable PDF file (ideally, PDF/X, make crop marks)

Other image file formats have to be exported (saved with Photoshop) as a TIFF or PSD document.

Color Mode

- > Profile «Adobe RGB (1998)» or in grayscale «Dot Gain 15 % »
Printing is done with the 12-color pigment ink system LUCIA EX
