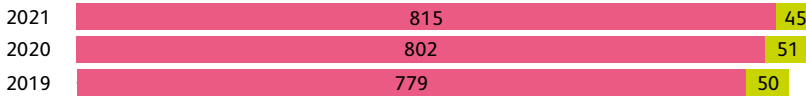


Lucerne School of Social Work

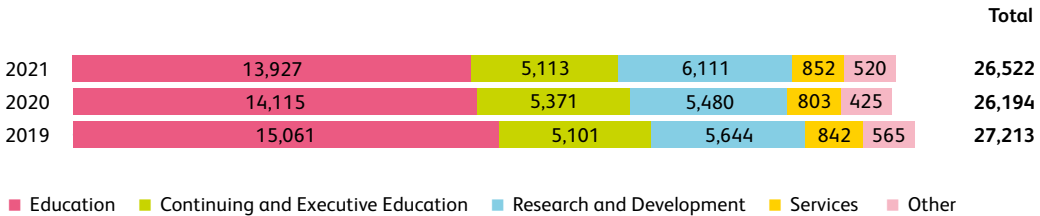
