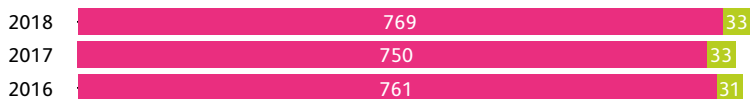

With 802 students enrolled in degree programmes and 1,855 participants in continuing and executive education programmes, it ranks among the larger Schools of Social Work in Switzerland.

802 students studied for a bachelor's or master's degree. Among them, 320 were enrolled in Social Work, 277 in Social Pedagogy and 172 in Socioculture. 33 students were in a master's programme. Women accounted for 73 % of the students.

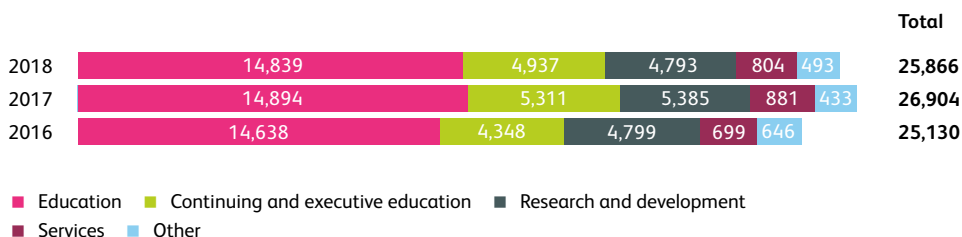
