

Tuition Fees

Master of Science in Information and Cyber Security Academic Year 2025/26

The amounts are based on the corresponding regulations and directives of the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts¹. Changes to the fees are reserved; the other amounts should be considered as guidelines.

- The registration fee is charged via invoice after registration. In the event of a cancellation, this fee remains payable and will not be refunded.
- Tuition fees are invoiced from the start of the respective semester. In the event of a cancellation after the semester has begun, the fees remain payable and will not be refunded (even without attending classes).

² In addition to the federal government, the cantons also contribute to study costs with so-called FHV contributions. However, they do not pay contributions for foreign students entering Switzerland for study purposes. Therefore, students whose civil residence is abroad at the time of enrollment will pay CHF 500 more per semester than domestic students from fall 2025, i.e., CHF 1300 instead of CHF 800. This applies for the entire duration of the study.
