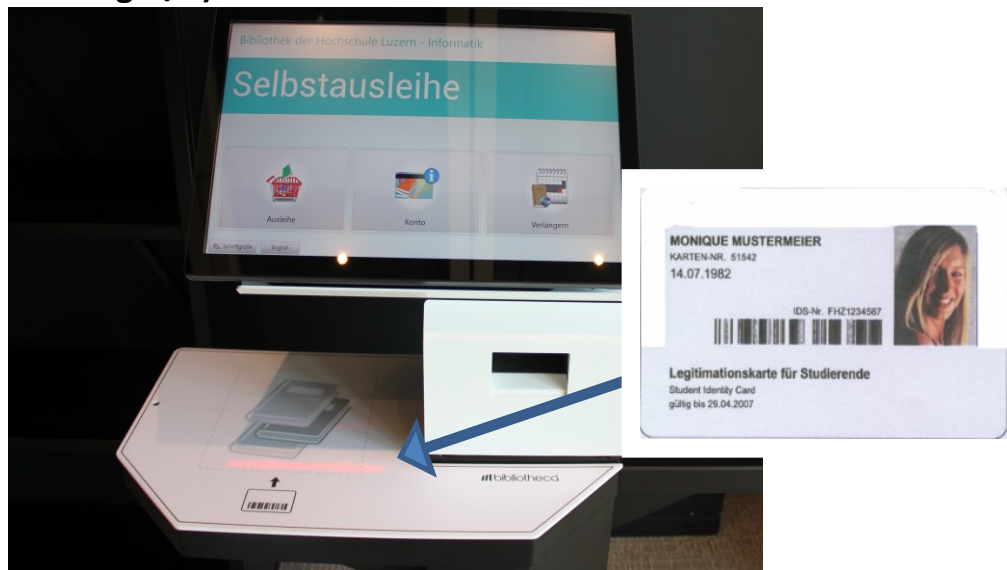


1 Check out and return

Bring a book to the self-checkout station, check it out and put it in the returns cart outside the library (in front of the connecting door building A/B).



IMPORTANT!

Place the book in the marked area (it's also possible to check out several books at the same time on it). The book then appears on the screen. Sign up with your HSLU-Card. A green check mark indicates that the book is correctly booked.

The loan period is four weeks (28 days). It can be extended for 28 days, if the item is not reserved. There will be five automatic extensions. You can also do the extensions manually in your library account, but the max. loan duration of 168 days cannot be over stepped.

NOTE

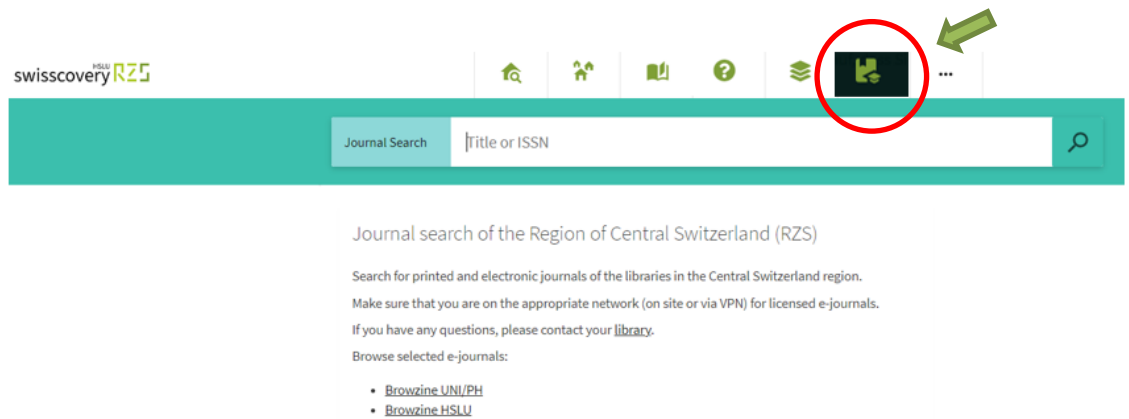
Borrowed items from all ZHB- and HSLU- libraries can be returned at any of these libraries to a returns cart or information desk regardless of where you checked them out.

2 Journals

3 Search and find in swisscovery RZS

The search portal swisscovery RZS contains numerous sources of information from the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts.

An example:

Open the **advanced search** in rzs-hslu.swisscovery.org. Look for books that include the term 'java' in the title.

Which of these books are available in the shelves of the library? Use the filter options and refine your hit list.

Log in to rzs-hslu.swisscovery.org with your personal access data and store your search results at any time. You can also manage your orders and personal data:

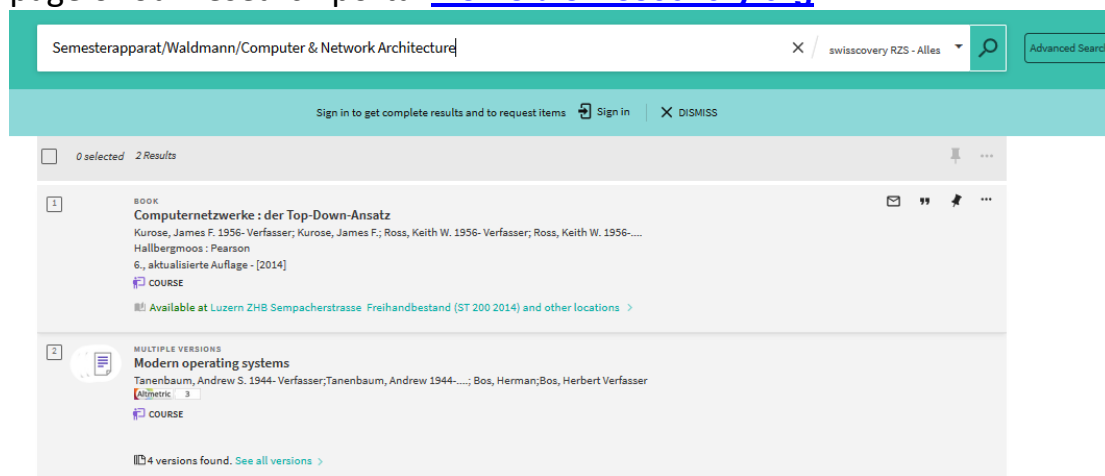

5 Course Reserves

Literature for your studies.

Various courses compose their literature (Print and electronical resources) in their own course reserves. These books are not loanable (reference collection). All students can view the books at any time at the library. The shelf with the course reserves is next to the lounge.

You can research the course reserves over the search slot on the main page of our research portal rzs-hslu.swisscovery.org:



The name of the course reserves includes the surname of the lecturer and the course name e.g. Semesterapparat/Waldmann/Computer & Network Architecture
