

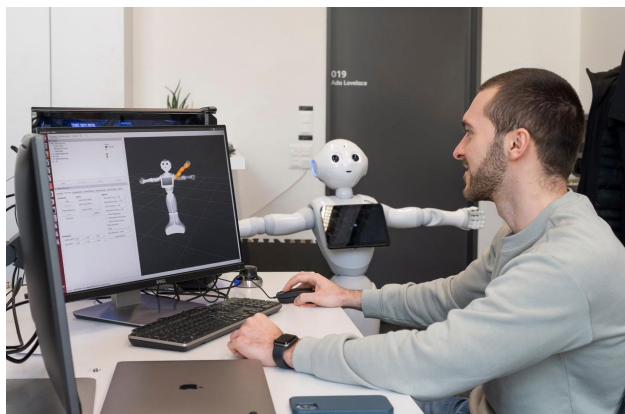

Academic Information	
Courses for Incoming Exchange Students	Courses can be found on our website for incoming students.
Grading System	From 1 – 6 (6 is the highest, 1 is the lowest grade, passing grade is 4)
European Credit Transfer System	The Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts uses the ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) and allocates ECTS credits to all undergraduate and postgraduate programs. In line with ECTS requirements, 60 ECTS credits measure the study load of a full-time student for one academic year. One ECTS credit equates to approximately 30 hours of study load for the student (to include attendance in class as well as outside of class study load such as: note-taking, self-study, homework, group work etc.)
Study Load per semester	Maximum: 30 ECTS / Minimum: 18 ECTS
Language Requirements	Proof of English Proficiency: CEFR B2 level (if English is not the student's mother-tongue and they are applying for courses taught in English) or Proof of German Proficiency: CEFR B2 level (if German is not the student's mother-tongue and they are applying for courses taught in German)
Admission Requirements	Students must have completed at least two semesters of study at their home university before their exchange semester at HSLU; proof of language proficiency; mandatory GPA 2.75 (out of 4) or above.
Language Courses	HSLU Language centre offers a wide range of language courses.
Course Registration	The HSLU Incoming Mobility Manager will carry out course registrations for international students in accordance with their predefined learning agreement. (NB: Registration in language courses do not apply). Students are required to apply on their own: information follows application.
Transcripts of Records	Transcripts are generally available three to five weeks after the last date of the exam window. The HSLU Incoming Mobility Manager will send the official transcript to the student's home institution and a copy for the student will be uploaded to the application tool (Mobility Online).
