

postgraduate programs. In line with ECTS requirements, 60 credits measure the workload of a full-time student during one academic year.

Full-time Study Load	Maximum of 30 ECTS per semester (minimum 18 ECTS). One ECTS points equals to 30 hours of work (lessons, self-study, homework, etc.).
Language Requirements	Proof of English Proficiency at least B2 level (if applying for courses taught in English and if not mother tongue) or Proof of German Proficiency at least B2 level (if applying for courses taught in German and if not mother tongue)
Admission Requirements	Have completed at least two semesters of study at the home university before mobility, proof of language proficiency, recommended GPA 2.75 or above
Language Courses	The University offers a range of language courses in its <u>language centre</u> .
