

Virtual Winter School 2021 modules

Entrepreneurship – Faculty of Business and Law

This module aims to help students to critically evaluate and identify their personal and business objectives with regards to new venture or value creation; to critically reflect upon their own values, goals and motivations to help develop their confidence to take entrepreneurial actions. It will help them to assess their entrepreneurial capabilities and skills as well as develop a learning map to summarise and plan their entrepreneurial development. This will be achieved through a series of individual and group based tasks that centre on idea generation, evaluation, and implementation, executed over a three-week period.

Intended Module Learning Outcomes

- Critically assess personal and business objectives.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the processes involved in idea generation, evaluation and implementation and present them to a panel.
- Reflection on learning and action planning

- 3. Identify own or organisational strengths in terms of entrepreneurship

- 9. Feasibility analysis and testing
- 10. Planning and implementing an idea
- 11. Presenting and pitching an idea
