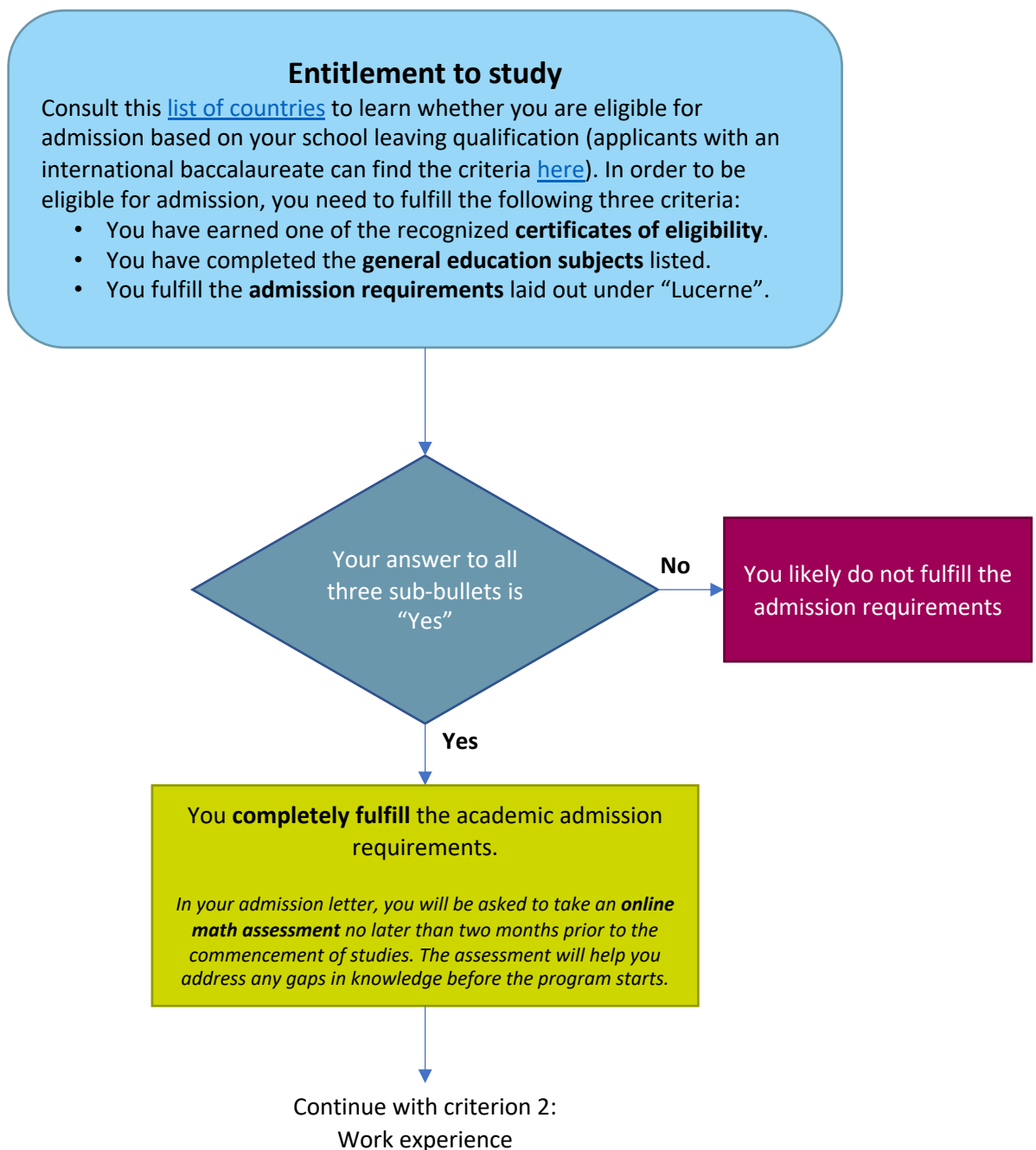


Self-assessment for admission to the Energy and Environmental Systems Engineering degree program

We are pleased that you are interested in the Energy and Environmental Systems Engineering degree program at the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts.

Your prior education qualifies you to study at a university level institution in your country of origin. The flow chart below can help you to assess your chances of admission to our university. The Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts will conduct the official admission examination once you have submitted your application. The admission examination focuses on three areas: (1) school leaving qualification, (2) work experience and (3) English language skills.
