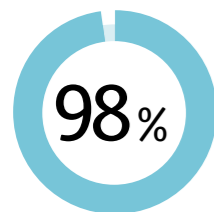

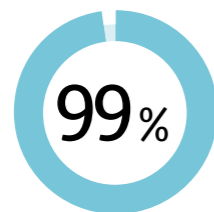

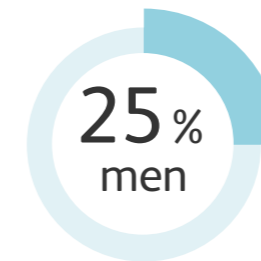
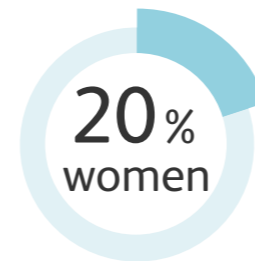

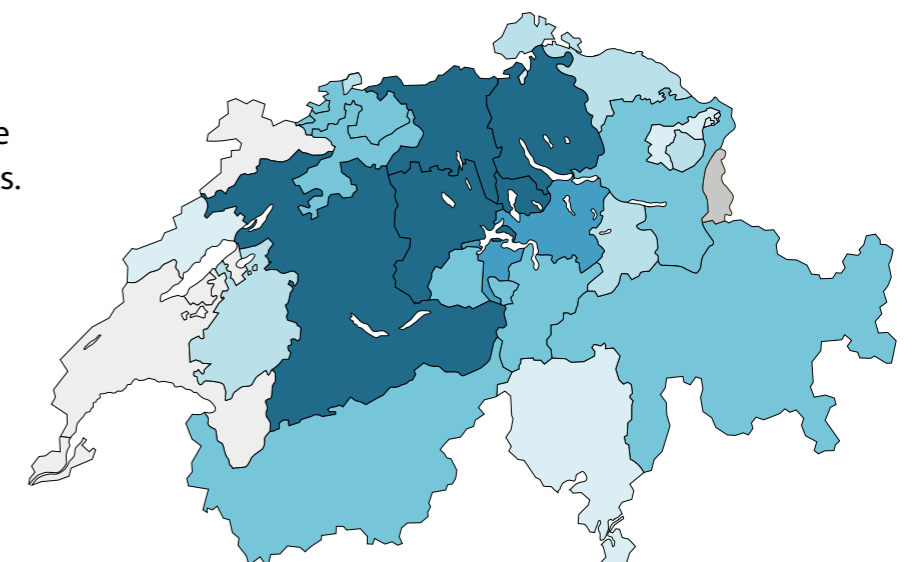

The map of Switzerland shows the origin of current Bachelor students.

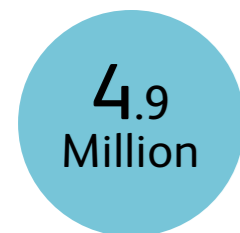

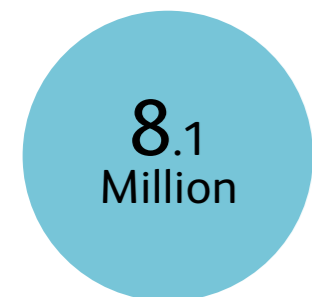
