- **Networking Access:** Connect with Swissnex's vast network of researchers, labs, entrepreneurs, and cultural leaders to drive your own project forward.
- On-Site Workspace: A dedicated desk at Swissnex's Pier 17 office with high-speed Wi-FI and shared facilities.
- **Visibility Opportunities:** Exposure to an extensive Bay Area audience through Swissnex's social media, events, and publications.



Residency Packages, Services and Pricing

We offer a range of residency packages designed to support participants with workspace access, coaching, networking, and visibility in the Bay Area ecosystem. Participants must secure funding through their institutions or third-party sources.
