

Admission Requirements for the B.Sc. International Business Administration (IBA)

- Applicants are exempt from the C1 English certificate requirement if they have attended an international school for more than two years.
- All prospective students must demonstrate at least 12 months (full-time equivalent) of relevant work experience in a business-related or commercial field prior to study start.
- Applicants with International School Qualifications are expected to present the following admission requirements:

Diploma type	Admission Criteria
International Baccalaureate (IB)	Recognized if at least 30 out of 42 points (without bonus points) are achieved (min. 3 at higher level). Subject-specific admission: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 subjects in different languages (first and second language) Language A: (native language), classical languages (Latin or classical Greek), language 'ab initio' (foreign language without prior knowledge), Language B (foreign language with prior knowledge). • 1 subject in mathematics at standard level or high level with a minimum grade of 5. • 1 subject in STEM (Science, technology, engineering, and mathematics): Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science, Design Technology or Environmental Systems and Societies. • 1 subject in humanities and social sciences: Business Management, Digital Society, Economics, Geography, Global Politics, History, Philosophy, Psychology, Social and Cultural Anthropology, World Religions, Environmental Systems and Societies. • 1 subject freely selectable either from the IB Diploma Programme (DP) catalogue or from the three groups mentioned above.
Advanced level (GCE A-Levels)	Total of 6 examinations: Minimum of 3 A-Level examinations , with the following distribution: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mathematics: 1 A-Level in Mathematics with grades A–C. • Sciences: 1 A-Level in Science subjects (e.g., Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science) with grades A–C. • Electives: 1 additional A-Level subject of the student's choice with grades A–C. Another A-Level in Science is strongly recommended as an elective. Additional 3 International A-Levels with minimum grade of 5 or B
Advanced Placement (AP)	Minimum of 4 AP examinations , with the following distribution: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mathematics: Calculus AB or Calculus BC (minimum grade of 3 or C). • Science: At least 1 science subject (minimum grade of 3 or C). • Electives: 2 AP subjects of the student's choice.
Combination of International Baccalaureate (IB) and Advanced Placement (AP)	Minimum of 4 examinations , with the following distribution: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mathematics: AP Calculus AB or AP Calculus BC (minimum grade of 3 or C), or an IB Mathematics subject with a minimum grade of 5 • Science: At least 1 AP science subject with a minimum grade of 3 or C. • Electives: 2 additional subjects chosen from AP or IB offerings.
