

## Budget plan for the Bachelor's Programme

Academic Year 2019/20

The table below provides a general survey of the costs involved in studying for a Bachelor's degree at the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts and may thus be of use to prospective students in working out a realistic personal budget.

The fees are based on the corresponding regulations of the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts<sup>1</sup>. Please note that fees may be subject to change and that non-fee figures should be taken as approximations only.

- Admission fees are invoiced directly after registration. The admission fee cannot be refunded in case of an application withdrawal.
- Tuition fees per semester must be paid in full by all students who are registered at the beginning of the semester concerned. Such fees are also owed in case of deregistration after the start of the semester (even if no classes have been attended).

For all other students, the fees are approximately CHF 10,000 per academic year. The fees are set on the basis of tariffs laid out in the Intercantonal Agreement on Universities of Applied Sciences (SRL Nr. 535). For the time being, Lucerne School of Business will assume these costs as part of a scholarship. These students will thus have the same status as those living in the Canton of Lucerne or in another canton that is subject to the agreement and their fees will amount to CHF 800 per semester.
