Costs pertaining to accommodation, travel and food are the responsibility of the participant and are not included in the tuition fee. Corporate rates for hotels or hotel recommendations will be provided if possible.

For students not currently enrolled in a degree program at Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts: Tuition costs are CHF 2,200 (including admission fees). Tuition includes the instruction of the course, the correction of assignments, certificates of achievement as well as the teaching materials (excl. textbooks and further specialist literature). Costs pertaining to accommodation, travel and food are the responsibility of the participant and are not included in the tuition fee. Corporate rates for hotels or hotel recommendations will be provided if possible.

*Students who wish to complete the MAS Business Management, but who wish to enroll in an International Week before officially starting the Master Module of the MAS Business Management, will be invoiced CHF 1,900 before the respective International Week. The CHF 1,900 will be deducted from the invoice of the Master Module of the MAS Business Management.

Registration and admission

After receipt of the completed written application, you will receive a confirmation that your application has been received. At the end of the registration deadline, the heads of program will make a definite decision regarding final admissions.

The heads of program reserve the right to hold a personal discussion with you before a confirmation of admission is issued.

If the number of eligible applications exceeds the number of available places, the heads of program may postpone individual applications. These candidates will then be offered a place for the next program start.

The heads of program take the final decision on the acceptance of applications.

If the number of applications is too low, the heads of the program can postpone or, if necessary, cancel the program. The applicants will be informed of this decision shortly after the application deadline. In case of a postponement or cancellation, candidates will be offered a place for the next program start.

Terms of payment and services

The tuition fee (if applicable; see above) is payable before the start of the program. The program costs include the instruction of the course, the correction of assignments, certificates of achievement as well as the teaching materials (excl. textbooks and further specialist literature). Costs pertaining to accommodation, travel and food are the responsibility of the participant and are not included in the tuition fee. Corporate rates for hotels or hotel recommendations will be provided if possible.

Cancellations

Cancellations received prior to the application deadline must be submitted in writing and will result in an administrative fee of CHF 350.

In the case of cancellations received after the application deadline, the entire course fee is due. Further, any pre-paid travel and accommodation costs incurred will not be reimbursed. Participants are responsible for ensuring that they have adequate insurance coverage.

Completion requirements

A prerequisite for the successful completion of the assignments and grading is regular attendance (fewer than 20% absences).
