Climate

The months of September and October have the potential to show visitors great Vancouver weather – mild, sunny and clear. There is actually no bad weather in Vancouver, but you do need appropriate clothing such as sunglasses, a sweater and a raincoat. Humidity is quite low thanks to ocean breezes. Temperatures from the end of September to the beginning of October can vary from highs of 20C during the day to lows of 10C at night.

Travel

Economy return flight from Zurich to Vancouver, BC, Canada approx. CHF 1,300 to CHF 1,400 (varies depending on how early the booking is made, choice of airline, seat selection, luggage etc.)

Accommodation

Approx. CHF 130 to CHF 160 /night + tax with the group booking code at the conference hotel, depending on the type of room, group rate and currency fluctuations. The prices are per hotel room so the room price is halved if you share a room.
